Whilst it not our company's policy to comment on confidential matters involving Governmental entities, we are aware of certain news media reports concerning labour welfare on one of our projects. The information contained in the newspaper article consist of material factual inaccuracies and misrepresentation. We have always outsourced our entire manpower requirements to local external vendor as required by Kuwait law. Such reports are therefore unfounded and rejected in their entirety.

We are satisfied the concerned Governmental authorities have taken action against the local company responsible for the labour's employment. You may wish to refer this matter to the relevant departments in Kuwait.
