I write in connection with your email communication to us, dated 21<sup>st</sup> December 2020, relating to the detention by Colombian police of Adelso Jose Galle Tozcano, I am happy to respond on behalf of BP, in my capacity as VP Social Sustainability.

BP now has no upstream oil and gas operations in Colombia, having sold our business in 2012 and no operations in the Arauca region. There is thus no connection with bp and we have no involvement with, or knowledge of, the incident and no previous dealings with Mr Tozcano on record.

Our Code of Conduct supports our commitment to respect human rights and our <u>Business</u> and <u>Human Rights policy</u> goes further in detailing our commitment, including to respecting the human rights of Human Rights Defenders.

Thank you again for your communication; BP will continue to engage contructively in discussion with BHRRC.
