Cellebrite is a powerful platform, and making sure it is used appropriately is of paramount importance to our mission.

Cellebrite has strict licensing policies and restrictions that govern how customers may utilize our technology. Our sales decisions are also guided by internal parameters, which consider a potential customer's human rights record and anti-corruption policies.

We sell our technology only to companies, bodies and agencies that abide by the terms that govern its proper use as outlined in our End-User Licensing Agreement (EULA). Customers that do not comply with these terms no longer receive active product support or have their licenses renewed. All resellers Cellebrite works with are subject to the same restrictions. Cellebrite does not sell to countries sanctioned by the U.S., EU, UK or Israeli governments.
