
Dear Ms. Ramos

This information is reported each year in our annual Sustainability Report, most recently on Page 66 of the [2020 Sustainability Report](#) issued in April of last year.

AngloGold Ashanti is proud of this track record of transparency, and our performance against the EITI Company Expectations can be reviewed in the first-ever [assessment](#) of adherence to the Expectations for EITI supporting companies, published last year.

As you know, the EITI's secretariat is currently undertaking a thorough review of these [Expectations](#) with the input of a wide group of stakeholders, a process aimed at further improving them.
