Thank you for giving us the opportunity to respond to Oxfam's concerns about gaps in the existing Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (EITI) Company Expectations, and the questions raised in their public letter to bp and 28 other EITI Board Members and US-listed EITI Supporting Companies. I am happy to respond on behalf of bp, in my capacity as SVP Sustainability.

bp supports transparency in the flow of revenue from our oil and gas activities to governments. This helps citizens hold public authorities to account for the way they use funds received through taxes and other agreements. bp is a founding member of the EITI, which supports the disclosure of payments made to and received by governments in relation to oil, gas and mining. In support of this transparency, Company Expectations for EITI Supporting Companies are being developed through an ongoing consensus-building process across different EITI constituencies. This process will continue to evolve in the coming months, led by the EITI Secretariat.

Thank you again for your communication; BP will continue to engage constructively in discussion with BHRRC.
