



Enel's reply to Business and Human Rights Resource Centre Invitation to respond on operations in Russia

In response to the question received by Business and Human Rights Resource Centre about Enel's operations in Russia, we would like to highlight that back on June 16, 2022, we announced the signing of agreements with PJSC Lukoil and private fund Gazprombank-Frezia to sell our entire stake in Enel Russia. The transaction concludes the sale of power generation assets in Russia, which Enel started in 2019 with the first sale of coal-fired assets, in line with the strategic aim of the Group to focus its activities mainly in countries where an integrated position along the value chain can drive growth and enhance value creation from the opportunities offered by the energy transition.

It should be noted that we had in any case already adopted or promoted some measures which resulted in the termination of management and coordination with regards to Enel Russia before the announcement.
