Survey questions for companies that have suspended operations in Myanmar following the attempted coup:

- 1. Has your company or subsidiary resumed business in Myanmar? If yes, can you briefly describe the nature, sector, scale, and geographic area of these operations or investments?
- 2. Prior to resuming your operations in Myanmar:
 - a. What human rights due diligence measures were undertaken by your company considering the ongoing human rights abuses committed by the military junta since the attempted coup on 1 February 2021?
 - b. Did you consult rights holders, including communities and workers as part of your decision-making process?
- 3. What are the actions your company has taken to:
 - a. Ensure that it does not have any business relationships with the Myanmar junta, or military owned, controlled, or affiliated entities, and
 - b. Mitigate any negative impacts of your operation on the rights holders?
- 4. Is your company or subsidiary taking any other actions to promote respect for humanitarian law, human rights, democracy, and peace in Myanmar?
