We have taken note of your message regarding allegations concerning one factory, Wanlin Zongheng, based in Cambodia. We take these allegations very seriously and are committed to ensuring the respect for human and workers' rights throughout our supply chain.

In Pimkie, we pay great attention to workers and human rights in our supply chain. As shared with you earlier this year, we closely monitor our supply chain and have a strong continuous improvement strategy on this matter, as we are currently implementing new traceability processes and tools.

For years, Pimkie has implemented a strict and contraignant control process for our suppliers, with mandatory social audits and frequent quality control on sites, which are reinforced by the strong business relationship built along the years with our suppliers.

Following your alert, we have launched an investigation on the mentioned factory in order to make sure that the production site is still aligned with our values, even in this challenging context for the textile industry.

We are ready to exchange with your organization and provide any additional information needed if necessary. We are open to dialogue and collaboration to find sustainable solutions that respect human rights and ensure fair working conditions.
