

Amazon's response re shareholder resolution

11 January 2019

Business & Human Rights Resource Centre invited Amazon to respond to a shareholder resolution filed by members of the Interfaith Center on Corporate Responsibility that requests that the Board of Directors prohibit sales of facial recognition technology to government agencies unless the Board concludes, after an evaluation using independent evidence, that the technology does not cause or contribute to actual or potential violations of civil and human rights.
