Response from Simmons Foods

The Business & Human Rights Resource Centre invited Simmons Foods to respond to a petition that alleges that Simmons is not fulfilling its responsibility to protect workers from harm caused by COVID-19 as it does not provide paid sick leave. The petition calls for Simmons Foods to provide paid sick leave benefits to poultry workers so that they do not need to continue working while ill to avoid loss of income, job, or penalty, including compensating workers for being quarantined or staying home to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus which could potentially harm more workers.
