

Northrop Grumman re shareholder resolution

Business & Human Rights Resource Centre invited Northrop Grumman to respond to a shareholder resolution filed by members of the Interfaith Center on Corporate Responsibility requesting that the Board of Directors prepare a report, at reasonable cost and omitting proprietary information, on Northrop Grumman's management systems and processes to implement its Human Rights Policy and noting concerns regarding racial bias, privacy and surveillance via the Homeland Advanced Recognition Technology (HART) database developed for the Department of Homeland Security.
