Dear Mr. Frederick,

We appreciate your response to our last letter, dated August 26th, 2011, and welcome your proposal for dialogue.

We are glad you have taken the time to evaluate the list of supplier companies with supervision records that was provided in the letter. In your e-mail, dated August 31st, 2011, you stated "*Several suppliers are not in our supply chain*". As we are in the process of finalizing a report on our findings we hope you can clarify for us which companies you have no relationship, we hope you can do as soon as possible.

Our August 26th letter was sent on behalf of five NGOs who are members of a wider coalition of Chinese environmental organizations named the Green Choice Alliance (GCA). We welcome dialogue with Apple Inc. to discuss the specifics of our findings, however, we insist on the inclusion of the GCA member NGOs who are actively involved in corporate monitoring and any other stakeholders who are potentially affected by, or concerned about, the pollution and injury caused by Apple's suppliers. We would like to invite Apple to attend a press conference on August 31st, 2011, were the specifics of our findings will be made know. Please contact us at +86-1305-1026-720, for further details.

We are willing to engage in initial joint communications however we feel it necessary to inform all stakeholders on the proceedings and outcomes of our discussions. Ultimately, we feel it is only appropriate that the other members of the GCA are informed and invited to participate in these talks.

As we cited in our earlier letters to Apple, China is facing a severe environmental challenge and we hope to see all stakeholders, including major corporations like Apple, joining in the efforts of pollution prevention and control.

Once again, we are encouraged by Apple's willingness to engage and hope we can communicate further on these very important issues.
